U11, U13 and U15 Girls Development Teams Season 2012

(The pathway to representative football & the Northern Tigers)

The Northern Tigers & KDSA Development are conducting a development program for Girls registered with KDSA clubs. You are invited to attend trials for our **U11, U13 and U15 Girls Development teams for Season 2012 – known as the KDSA Tigers.**

The program is designed to develop soccer techniques and enable girls to reach their full potential, as well as providing them with a future pathway to Representative football. If places become available in our Representative teams during the season, replacement players will be selected from the Development teams.

Entry to the program will be by selection over a series of Trial evenings (attendance at all trial sessions is required).

The squads will play in the KDSA Saturday Mixed Competitions, with an early afternoon timeslot (Special Time Request). If selected, the Girls can still play with their KDSA club side in the Sunday Girls competition if they so wish.

Trial dates: Tuesday 31st January & Thursday 2nd February, then Tuesday 7th February & Thursday 9th February 2012, at Koola Park, Koola Road, Killara.

**Trial times: U11 (Born 2002, 2001) - Start 5.00pm and finish at 6.00pm
U13 (Born 2000, 1999) - Start 5.30pm and finish at 6.30pm
U15 (Born 1998, 1997) - Start 5.30pm and finish at 6.30pm**

Girls will train Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5.00pm, initially pre-season at Koola Park, Koola Road, Killara, and then in-season at St Ives Showground, Mona Vale Road, St Ives.

The fee is \$850 for the 30-week program, which includes:

- 60 training sessions (Tuesdays and Thursdays)
- Saturday game (early afternoon) in the KDSA Mixed competition, with all registration fees
- Uniform kit comprising playing and training strip, tracksuit, kit bag, water bottle
- Training ground hire & training equipment

Coaching staff are FNSW qualified Northern Tigers Womens Representative Coaches and Northern Tigers Senior Women players, (all with FFA Licence accreditation).
