I am delighted to announce that KDSA will be supporting the You Can campaign to raise funds to help build youth cancer centres throughout Australia.

This campaign calls on all Australians to donate their old mobile phones which will be recycled to raise money for the establishment of these youth cancer centres.

Cancer is the leading cause of disease-related death amongst Australia's teenagers with 1 in 100 people diagnosed before the age of 30.

With your help, we can do our little bit to help this worthwhile cause achieve a great goal.

How you can help....

Planning for our end of season Gala Day weekend (27/ 28 Aug) is well underway. At each of our 11 main centres (9 SSF locations and the 2 finals venues) we will have bright yellow collection boxes for you to **deposit your old mobile phones**. If you forget to remove the SIM card, it will be destroyed and any personal data on the phone will be wiped as part of the recycling process.

With almost 16,000 players within the KDSA, I'm sure we can easily collect at least 5,000 phones – if you are anything like my household, we have at least 4 old phones lying around!
